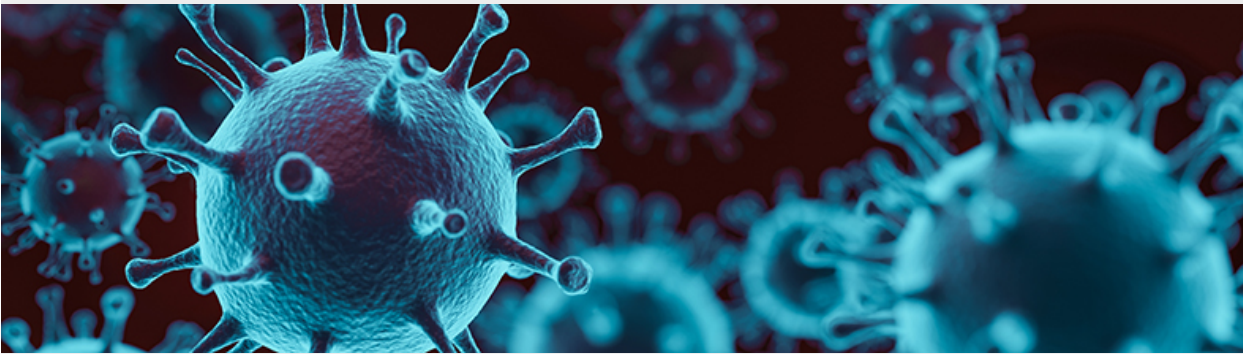


# Florida Coronavirus Update
