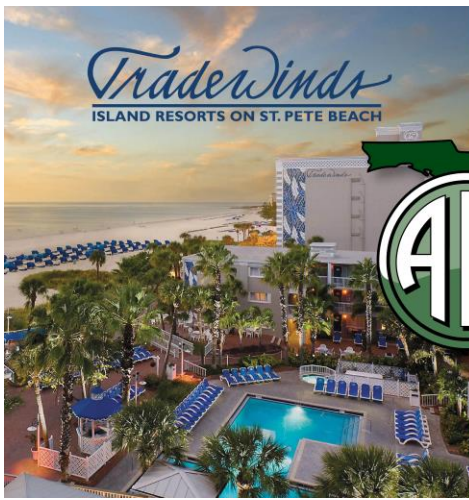

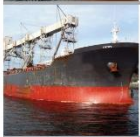
Environmental Sustainability & Agriculture Council (ESAC)
